

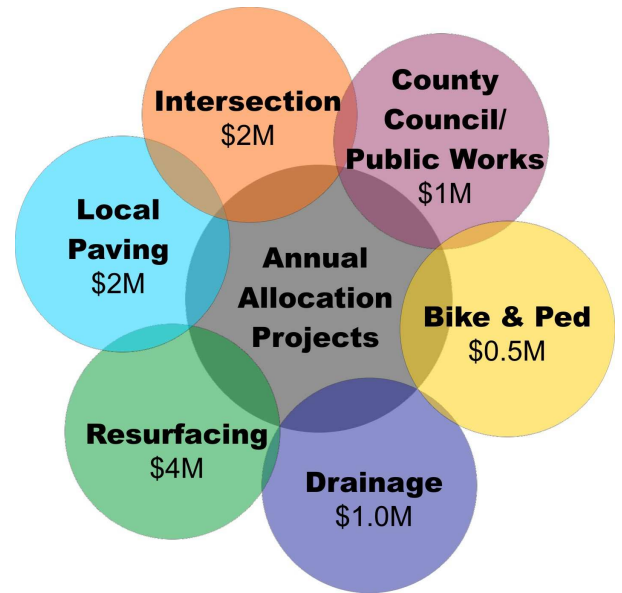
Victoria Avenue Sidewalk Project Public Meeting August 19, 2008



General Information Regarding the RoadWise Program

In November 2004, the citizens of Charleston County voted to enact a half-cent sales tax to be used for the purposes of transportation improvements, greenbelt facilities and mass transit. Collection of the tax began in May 2005 and continues for 25 years or until \$1.3 billion is collected.

In October 2006, Charleston County Council approved to annually allocate funds for road improvements as needs arise. The project categories and annual allocations are illustrated in the graph shown.



The Victoria Avenue Sidewalk Project

The Victoria Avenue Sidewalk Project was identified and approved as a Fiscal year 2008 (July 1, 2007 – June 30, 2008) Local Paving Project.

The project begins at the intersection of Park Place and North Rhett Avenue, and the proposed sidewalk will be constructed along the north side of Park Place up to Victoria Avenue. The sidewalk will continue along the east side of Victoria Avenue ending at the existing sidewalk on Maxwell Street. The project distance is approximately 4,600 feet and includes a five-foot wide concrete sidewalk.
